

ELIGIBILITY FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY GROUPS

Groups falling under the College of the North Atlantic (CONA) who wish to apply for a lottery licence must do so under the name of the College and not under the name of the class or organization, eg. if the Business Management III class of the St. John's campus wishes to apply, they would so under "College of the North Atlantic (CONA) - Student Representative Council, St. John's". Before a licence is issued the application must be signed by the Student Representative Council President, or in his or her absence an executive member of the student union, and the Student Development Officer from the applicable college.

Groups falling under Memorial University of Newfoundland must do so under the name of the faculty, school, society, club, sport team or the student union. The name should not include the year of the class or a committee name. Before a licence is issued the application must be signed by at least one person in accordance with the following:

Faculties and Schools - Dean or his/her designate;

Societies, Clubs and Student Unions - President of the appropriate student union, or in his or her absence an executive member of the student union (MUNSU)(MISU)(GSU)(GCSU);

Sports Teams - Director of the School of Human Kinetics and Recreation or his/her designate.

For eligibility of other college groups the applicant must be the Student Union. The name should include the name of the college but not the year of the class or a committee name. Before a licence is issued the application must be signed by the president of the student union or in his or her absence an executive member of the student union.
